A programme of guided and themed tours for adults and workshops and interactive tours for families and children in Italian, English and French.

Cinecittà is expanding its cultural offer for the summer: **from 4 June to 4 September 2022**, a calendar of **special tours**, **tours in foreign languages and routes dedicated to families** will give every visitor the opportunity to make new and exciting discoveries about the famous Studios, the blockbuster sets, and the Cinecittà Shows Off and <u>MIAC-Italian Museum of Moving Images exhibition routes</u>.

The Summer 2022 programme features **workshops in English and French** for the first time, created for the youngest of visitors: an educational proposal that links exploration of cinema with knowledge of a foreign language. Participants will discover the technical terms used in the world of film in a foreign language, while experiencing the dreamy atmosphere of the city of cinema.

Dive into Miac: discovering the audiovisual

Workshop for children

When: 10.30 a.m., Sunday 3 & 31 July

A journey of discovery through the fascinating history of Italy's audiovisual and cinema industry from the earliest inventions to the latest technology following the interactive timeline of the Museum route and the immersive installations dedicated to the magic of the silver screen and its stars. A route that brings old and young visitors into the buildings that were formerly Cinecittà's development and print laboratories and offers them the challenge of trying some small cinema experiments.

Professions in film

Workshop for children

When: 10.30 a.m., Sunday 10, 17, 24 July & 4 September

A visit that introduces some key phases in producing a movie – screenwriting, directing, set and costume design – through a guided tour of Backstage. An interactive, didactic tour of Cinecittà and a workshop where participants can try inventing and storyboarding a narrative, creating a character and their costumes, and designing a set for the story with all its furnishings. The workshop activity offers the opportunity to create unique digital storytelling about the professions in filmmaking as a permanent souvenir of the experience.
