The city of cinema and its architecture: the architectural project behind Cinecittà

Guided tour of the original buildings of the city of cinema, its soundstages and complex architectural structure to discover the origins and development of the country's most famous film studios, designed by the great architect Gino Peressutti and inaugurated in 1937. A journey that brings visitors into contact with the history of the dream factory to discover the inspiration behind the project and the stylistic and functional elements that still characterise the studios of Via Tuscolana today.

Clothes to die for: costumes from Italian cinema at Cinecittà Shows Off

Guided tour of the exhibition – Sunday 29 August 11.00 am

A special guided tour of the original costumes on display that tell the story of Italian cinema and the fabulous work hidden in the making of these clothes designed by internationally renowned designers. A unique opportunity to discover the new costumes that are on display this year to celebrate the centenaries of three great artists - Alida Valli, Nino Manfredi, Giulietta Masina - through some of the unforgettable characters that made them famous.

Fabulous Set Dressing

Dive into MIAC: discovering the audiovisual

A route that brings old and young visitors into the buildings that were formerly Cinecittà's development and print laboratories and offers the challenge of trying some small cinema experiments.

Photocinema: click and action

A guided tour for families – Saturday 17 July 11.00 am

An interactive route through the sets and parkland of Cinecittà in the guise of a director of photography to develop the link between film and photography: visual plays, picture framing comparisons, testing filters, lights and gels allow participants to create a unique sequence of film shots!
